

Year 6 Overview

During Term 3 in Italian, the children will revise, extend and consolidate on the Italian phrases and terms they have learnt so far this year. When learning a new language, repetition is necessary for fluency and pronunciation.

In Year 6, we will continue to focus on the following:

- How to greet each other in Italian. (I saluti)
- Use their manners. (Manieri)
- Introduce themselves (Come ti chiami? Mi chiamo...)
- Numbers 1-100 (Numeri)
- How old are you? (Quanti anni hai?)
- How many? (Quanti sono?)
- How much? (Quanto costa?)
- Colours (Colori)
- How are you? (Come stai?)
- Days of the week. (Giorni della settimana)
- Months of the year (Mesi dell'anno)
- Basic conversation skills.

In addition,

- We will be focusing on the Italian culture and the regions within Italy. The children will be able to name some regions and provinces in Italy
- Name some fruits (frutta) and vegetables (verdure).
- Name other foods eg. Meat, milk etc.
- Learn the names of the meals in Italian. For example, dinner is cena.
- Explore a typical Italian menu and the courses within it.
- Name items you find on the dinner table.
- Name some animals.
- Use Italian words to describe our emotions.

All the learning is carried out using songs, games, stories, direct instruction, craft, worksheets, conversation, role-play, videos and power point presentations.
