Technology Code of Conduct Policy

This document relates to the acceptable use of technology at St Benedicts school. It also highlights the consequences of actions that are deemed unacceptable by the school leadership team.

The purpose of this document is to ensure all students and parents are aware of the expectations of the school when utilising technology.

User Responsibility (Students)

1. Ensure content that is on the device is suitable, age appropriate and legal.
2. Maintain the Catholic Ethos the School if using the device
3. Report any damage immediately to their teacher.
4. Use the device for their intended purpose.
5. Transport and store the device in a safe and secure manner at all times when not in use.

Unacceptable Use (Students)

1. Identity theft will not be tolerated
2. Using ICT without permission or without supervision by a teacher.
3. Visiting any site that has not been approved by the teacher.
4. Using the Internet to access offensive or inappropriate information.
5. Interfering with files belonging to others.
6. Downloading anything without the teacher's permission.
7. Bullying, frightening, annoying or upsetting a person using the iPad is strictly prohibited.

Loss or Damage

In the event of loss or damage, students must immediately report the incident to their teacher.

Consequences

If students do not adhere to the Technology Code of Conduct policy, they will not be given the privilege of utilising a device at St Benedict's school.
